


## Step 1: PRINT OUT THIS CHART

To make sure you are measuring correctly, print this document on A4 paper at 100% (hint: uncheck -page scaling-).

To double check the scale, place a credit card over the box below and it should fit perfectly.



## Stop 9: MEASURE BOTH FEET

Get your little person to stand on a flat surface against a wall with their foot on the printout. Make sure their heel is in the heel curve.

Place a mark at the very tip of the longest toe (usually the big toe.). Record their measurement in the box above. Repeat for the other foot.

## Step 3: TIME TO ORDER!

Most people have one foot bigger than the other. Base your child's shoe size on the largest measurement. Visit our sizing page to establish what size you need in the styles you wish to purchase.
